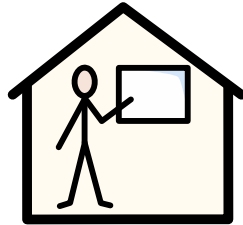
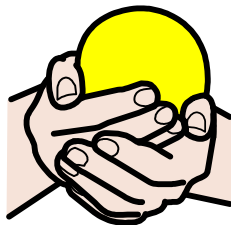

online.



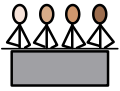


What is this?

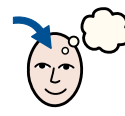
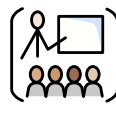
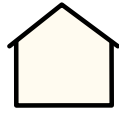




How will we try to protect all pupils?

know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy.



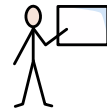
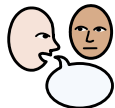
Staff and visitors



All staff and visitors to our school have to sign in at the

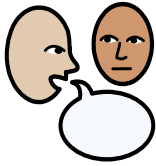


office and wear a lanyard. Tell an adult if you see someone in



school who is not wearing the correct lanyard.

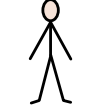
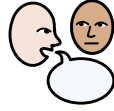

Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes or alcohol



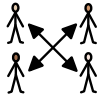
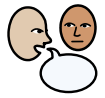
